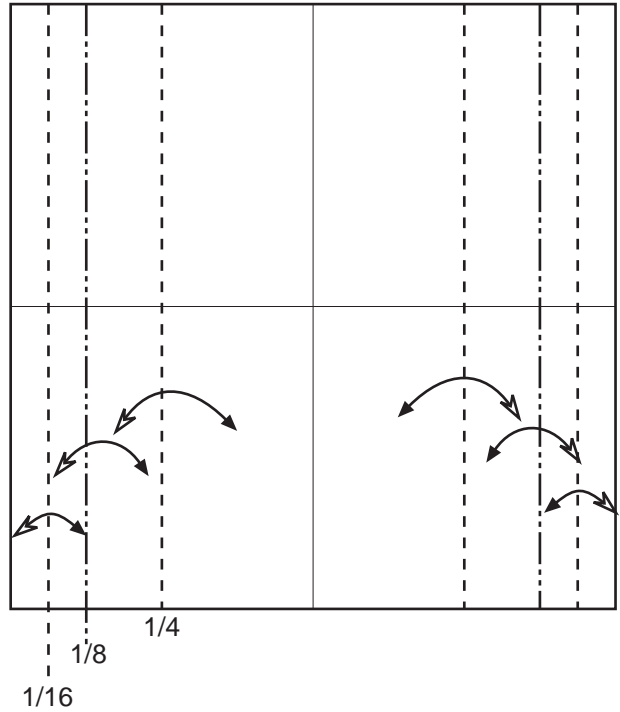
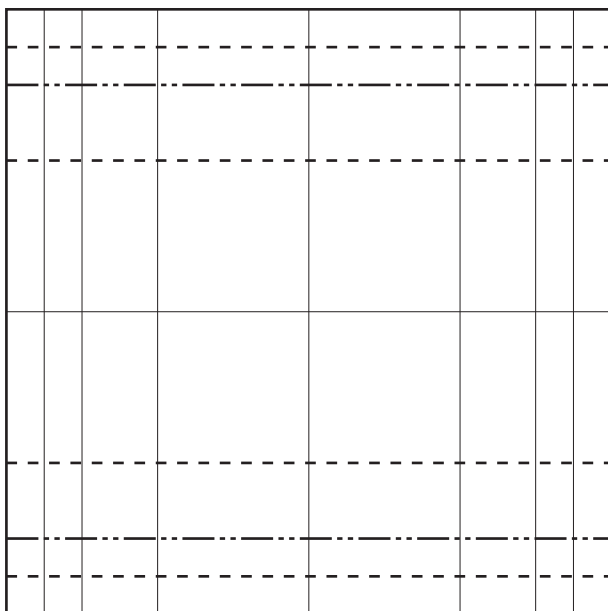


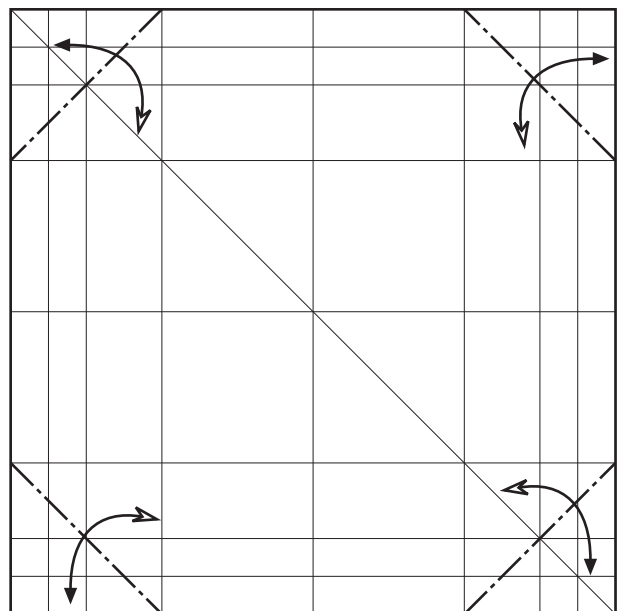
1. Start with paper white side up and crease in half then unfold.



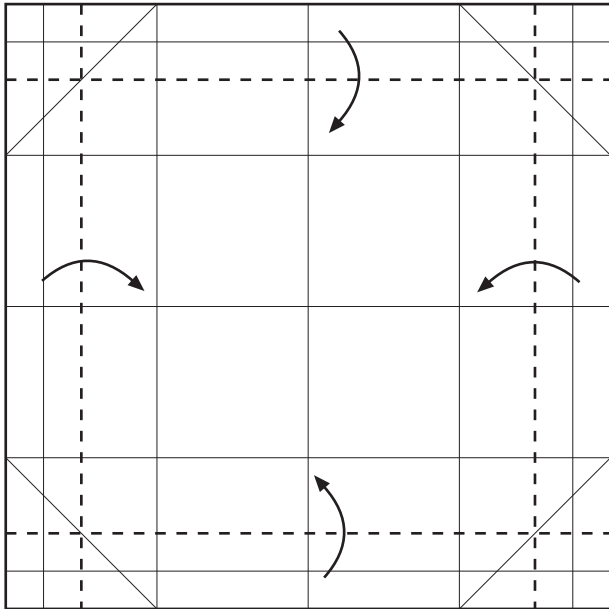
2. Make the following creases and unfold.



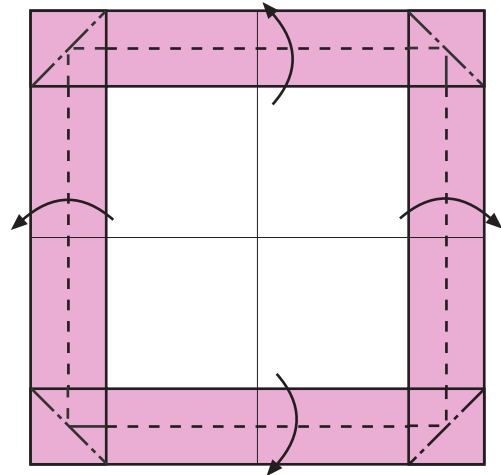
3. Now repeat in the vertical direction.



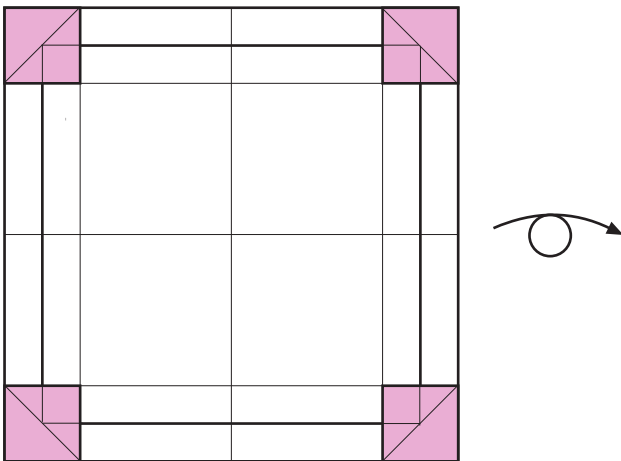
4. Mountain fold corners and unfold.



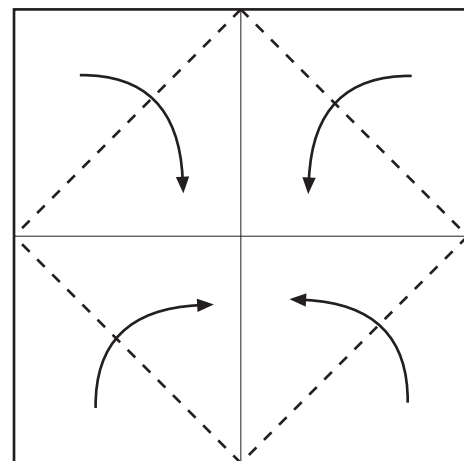
5. Valley fold along existing 1/8th creases. This will form bird bases in the corners.



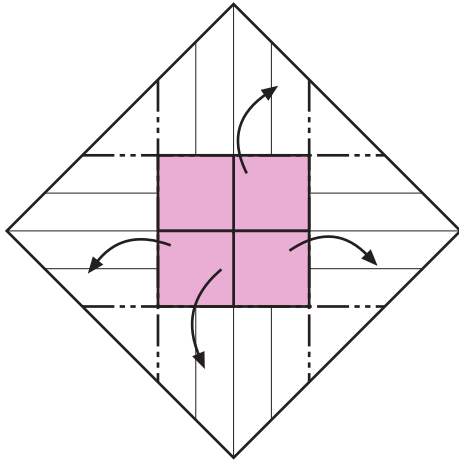
6. Valley fold along existing 1/16th creases to remove color paper this extends under the bird base. Notes the corner work is a little tricky.



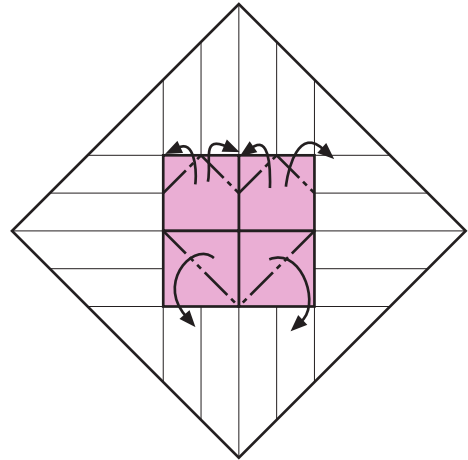
7. This should be the result. Now turn over.



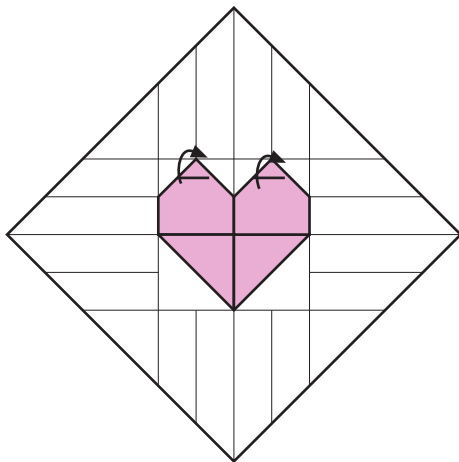
8. Fold all the corners to the center.



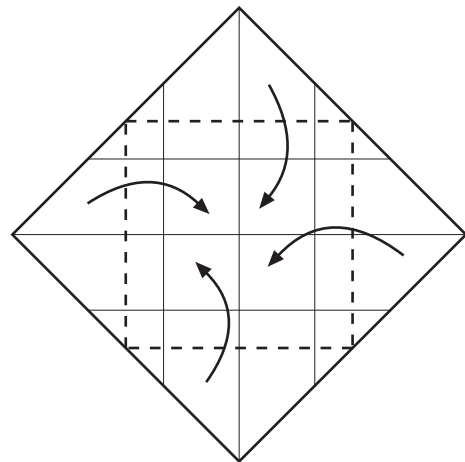
9. Mountain fold along existing lines. These are the 1/8th lines



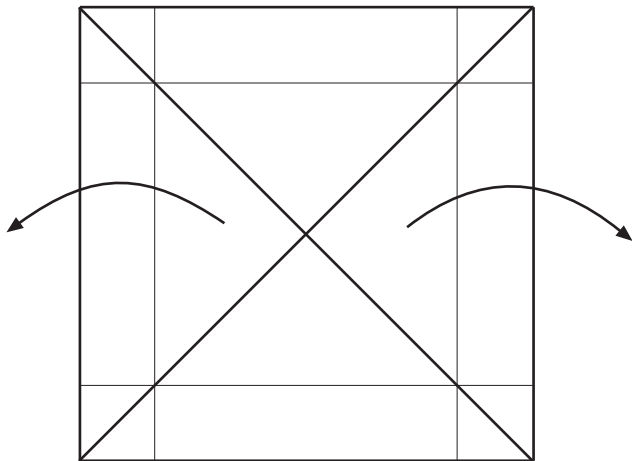
10. More mountain folds.



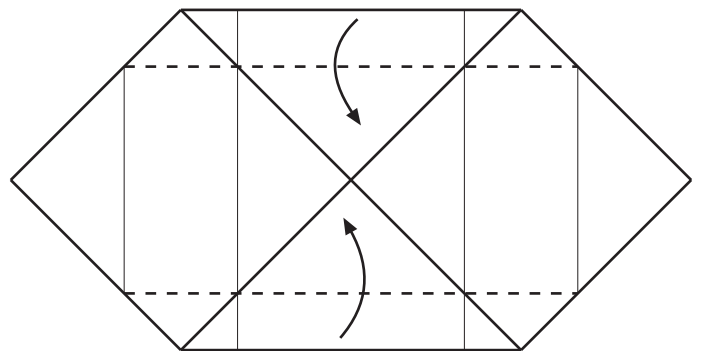
11. And more. Now turn over.



12. Fold the corners to the center.



13. Now unfold left and right flaps.



14. Continue with traditional Masu Box.
